A BIT OF NEWS ABOUT CHEON IL GUK INCORPORATION STATUS

As most of you know, OMS is a service provided by Cheon Il Guk Incorporated. Cheon Il Guk Incorporated was established as a not-for-profit organization in 2011. However, since the IRS has not yet granted that status, donations have been limited. An application to the IRS was made in 2011 but withdrawn a year later when it was clear that the IRS was not going to grant the nonprofit status to a match-making organization.

In January of this year, a new 501c3 application was completed. This time the involvement of Cheon Il Guk Incorporated with the Unification Church is clearly defined and explained. I believe that now we have a much better chance to receive our status as a not-for-profit organization although it is still going to take time as the IRS has a serious backlog of applications. In addition, Cheon Il Guk Incorporated is starting to get involved with a second project that is also very important to our Unification Movement. It has to do with the testimonies of the missionaries that were sent to 95 nations in 1975. These testimonies need to be preserved for history, but should also be read

by the general public. They are treasured stories that testify to God's work in immeasurable ways.

I want you to know that I am not working in Cheon Il Guk by myself. Cheon Il Guk Incorporated has two other dedicated board members, Crescentia DeGoede who is also in charge of the Blessing and Family Ministry USA, and Andrea Mylar-Hayashi who is a college student at this time.

A BIT ABOUT REQUESTING FULL PROFILES

There are candidates who prefer to be actively involved with the choice of their Blessing partners. Hence, they might feel the need to contact the candidate whose profile they feel is more compatible to theirs. Because requesting another candidate's full profile may be a challenging undertaking that may cause some heartache, the OMS invites every candidate whose full profile has been requested to be mindful and reply to the request promptly.

To avoid requesting a wrong full profile or sending the request to a candidate whose profile might not be compatible, it is recommended that the candidate who wishes to request a full profile print the other candidates' limited profiles in order to review them offline against one's own profile. To print a limited profile, select the whole profile (Ctrl+A), copy it to the clipboard (Ctrl+C), open a new Word document and then paste the copied text (Ctrl+V) to the new Word document.

The OMS is working on making a "Print" button available for those who would prefer to print limited profiles rather than copy and paste them. This function will be available by March 15.

Just to reiterate, those who receive a full profile request ought to be mindful that the person who made the request might be anxiously awaiting the response. Therefore, it is better to respond to it in a timely fashion.

It has come to my attention that you may not be aware that you have the ability to read the emails exchanged between your candidate and another candidate. This can be done simply by

clicking on the little envelope on the right end side of your screen, on the same line as the other information about the candidate. It is important that you read these messages. Candidates *expect* you to read them, so you can give them the support they are seeking from you.


