#### A note about non-USA applicants and the matching process:

Please note: Anyone who lives in the USA and who wants to be approved by the Blessed Family Ministries of USA as a blessing candidate <u>needs to change their original country membership!</u> This has little to do with immigration. Under present guidelines, if you remain a member of the church in another country the match needs to be approved by the blessed family leadership of that country. Changing the country of membership to the US (or wherever) is not a very difficult process and is just one more step in the process.

### What is being done with OMS at this time:


