OMS UPGRADE BEGINS THURSDAY APRIL 16, 2015

The Online Matching System – OMS – will be **unavailable** from Tuesday 4:00pm EST to Wednesday 11:59pm EST due to maintenance and upgrade.

NEW FEATURES

Starting April 13, 2015 –

Blessed Children will be able to register on OMS. Blessed Children already have two choices of online databases and OMS provides their third. Each is a choice, not an obligation.

OMS has proven itself to be a useful tool for First Generation candidates and their Advisors. We believe that OMS will also provide a great service in the search for a spouse to our ever growing community of Blessed Children.

One of the most important features OMS offers is the ability to email a potential candidate anonymously. We believe this feature is unique to OMS and helps keep the privacy of both parties intact until such a time that both agree to share their full profiles with one another.

Parents of Blessed Children will be able to access OMS database just as Sponsors for our First Generation do. They will be able to follow the progress of their adult child in the creation of their profile and also search the database for potential matches.

Parents will also be able to use a similar message system as the candidates. Parents will be able to communicate, anonymously (if they so choose) with other parents about their adult child. This privacy is important, especially if sensitive information needs to be shared before actual contact is made

UPDATED FEATURES WITH OMS

About the Matching Candidate Applications:

Up to now, OMS agreed to change the status of an individual from Applicant to Candidate upon the recommendation of the Matching Advisor. Now that Blessed Children will become part of OMS and a Matching Advisor may not be involved, a new system has been created to assure that every person with the status of "Candidate" on OMS has been approved by their own national Blessed Family Department.

To make this happen, we ask the following:

 Every North-American Candidate (First Generation and Blessed Children alike from Canada, The Caribbean, and USA) upload their Matching Candidate Application on OMS.

• Individuals of other continents and nations upload a document signed by their own BFD certifying that they have met all Blessing requirements and thus are a genuine Matching/Blessing Candidate.

What happens to people who are already on OMS in the status of "Candidate" but have not provided their Matching Candidate Application?

Such individuals will remain candidates and Matching Advisors will be able to see their OMS profile. However, these individuals will no longer be able to access the list of Potential Candidates until they upload their Matching Candidate Application.
