Since November 2014 another major upgrade took place. The Online Matching System now offer its services to all the **adult children of Unificationists**. They have had the opportunity for several years to use two other online matching sites, this one will be the third offered to them. The use of OMS differs from the others



and may very well serve a segment of our growing young adult community very well. <u>The launch of this upgrade was April 1st, 2015</u>.

Parents have the opportunity through OMS to discuss with other parents <u>anonymously</u> just like their children have the opportunity to do so with other candidates. We feel that this feature is very important and necessary for both the candidates and their parents.

Parents! You can do it too.

The Messaging System for Parents of Candidates works similarly than for the Candidates. The main difference is that messages between Parents are private. They are not forwarded to any matching advisors, sponsors, or their children. The parents have complete control about how much they want to share anonymously with another set of parents. It is up to them when they wish to share their own credentials.

In today's world of online dating and social media being catfished is not necessarily uncommon. How are we to know truly the quality of the person on the other end of the screen?

Candidates! don't be "catfished"

OMS is the one system where certain steps need to be taken first before one can become a candidate.

Therefore, as a candidate when you are able to search and be searched, you know for sure that each person you see has gone through a set of procedures— Blessing 2 workshop, health verification, blessing interview—to prove, for one thing, that they are a real person and most importantly that they have shown some commitment to the blessing.

What we did in 2015 and what we want to do in 2016.

Widows and widowers is a growing community. Companionship is important at any age but especially as some people reach the golden years. The board of Cheon II Guk Incorporated feels that there is no reason why one should spend it alone.



In addition, some young Unificationist families who suffered the loss of a spouse and have **young children** may benefit from finding a partner with whom to share their physical life and co-parent their children. OMS is there for them.
